The information contained in this page exclusively affects those who must pay the fees to the Spanish Agency for Medicines and Healthcare Products, hereinafter SAMHP, and without a business address in Spain, nor a representative. In case of being resident please check the right instructions.

The SAMHP assumes the rendering of services and activities in the matter of Medicinal Products included in the following groups of the Medicines Act, according to the wording of Law 29/2006, of 26 of July (B.O.E. 27 of July):

- Group I: Proprietary Medicinal Products.
- Group II: Traditional Herbal Medicinal Products.
- Group III: Homeopathic Medicinal Products.
- Group IV: Medicinal Gases.
- Group V: Clinical Investigation.
- Group VI: Inspections upon request of the interested party.
- Group VII: Reports and Certifications.
- Group VIII: Medical Devices, cosmetics and hygienic products.
- Group IX: Veterinary Medicinal Products.

The persons and entities not resident in Spain who should apply to the SAMHP, the execution of their competent activities or services regarding medicinal products, should pay the corresponding fees. This can be done by bank transfer to the Agency's collections bank account. The SAMHP doesn't admit checks neither entrance in cash.

The bank account is opened in the name of the SAMHP in BBVA, number:

The money deposit in the SAMHP's Account by this procedure must be exactly the same, no matter the currency is, to the established rates in peseta/Euro hereby enclosed, depending on the group of the requested activity.

In accordance to this, those who make the transfer in favour of the SAMHP should consider the commissions and intermediary cost of the financial agencies, adding this amount to the amount of payment ordered.

In the case that the amount received in the collections account does not coincide with the amount required for the execution of the activities requested from the Agency, this activity cannot be initiated until the payment is completed.

When this procedure is used for the payment of fees, the requesting persons or entities should enclose a copy of the bank transfer together with the application documents in order to be able to reconcile the documents of request with the corresponding bank account transaction for the payment of fees.

**IMPORTANT:** Art. 113.4 Law 29/2006, of 26 of July: **Once paid the fees, the interested will present the application in the SAMHP before three months from their payment.**
